of y^e christian ^{faith}, and honour of our king & countrey, a roayal^t to
plant y^e first Colonie in y^e Northern parts of Virginie. God
by these presents solemnly & mutually in y^e presence of god, and
one of another, Covenant, & combine our selues together into a
Ciuit^t body politick; for ^{our} boder ordering, & preseruation & fur-
therance of y^e ends aforesaid; and by vertue hereof, to enacte,
constitute, and frame such just & equal lawes, ordinances,
Act^s, constitutions, & offices, from time to time, as shall be thought
most meete & convenient for y^e generall good of y^e Colonie: Unto
which we promise all due submission and obedienc^e. In witnes
whereof we have hereunder subscribed our names at Cap-

Lord King James of England, frane, & Irelaland y^e eighteenth
